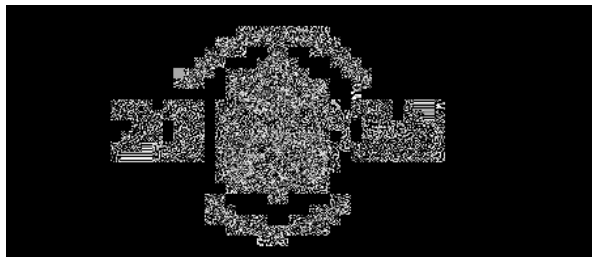
### *Project Children*
