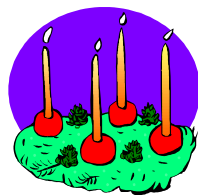

### THANKSGIVING TURKEY DRIVE UPDATE

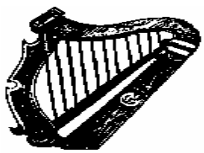

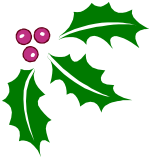
