THANKSGIVING TURKEY DRIVE UPDATE

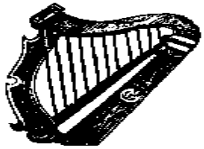

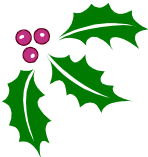
