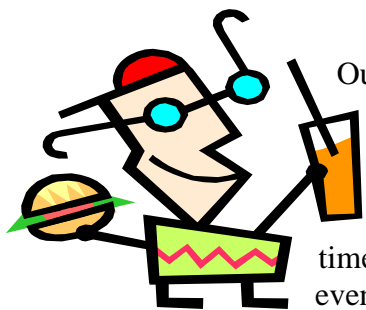

### *St. Patrick Division's Annual Picnic*



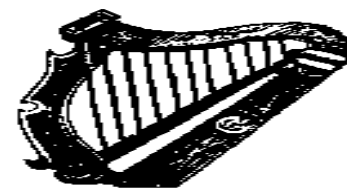
