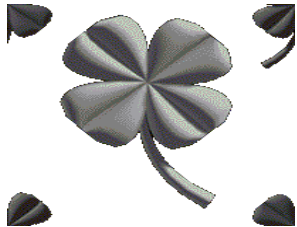

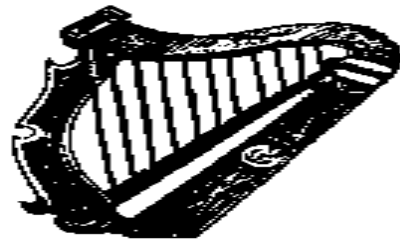

HIBERNIAN MEMBERSHIP DRIVE

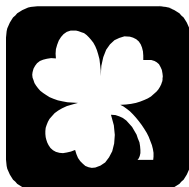
