## **2009 ANNUAL THANKSGIVING DINNER PROJECT**

We package and deliver between 50 – 60 baskets of food to needy families on the Monday (11/23) before Thanksgiving. We are asking for your support in feeding the hungry and our needy neighbors this year.



### **How you can help**

#### **DONATE NON-PERISHABLE FOOD:**

Our standard baskets contain: Stove Top stuffing, cranberry jelly, boxes of Jello, canned vegetables (green beans, corn, etc.), and canned gravy. Of course, any other type of canned good is welcome.

#### **DONATE FROZEN TURKEYS**

Every basket starts with a turkey. Storage space is not available, so please drop off your frozen turkeys either Sunday night or Monday morning at locations listed below.



#### **CASH DONATIONS**
